Acting Medical Director

Dr. Julia Shiner serves as the Acting Medical Director for Federal Occupational Health (FOH). This role requires Dr. Shiner to provide medical oversight to clinical staff in more than 300 occupational health centers across the county, directly providing medical consultation to customer agencies and writing and reviewing medical standards for working populations.

Additionally, Dr. Shiner creates, reviews, and approves policies and standard operating procedures (SOPs) governing all aspects of patient care provided by FOH. As such, Dr. Shiner is responsible for providing medical leadership to support the FOH Director and the Office of Performance, Analysis, and Quality charged with maintaining system accreditation by The Joint Commission.

Dr. Shiner transitioned to the position of Acting Medical Director in May, 2015, after serving as an occupational medicine consultant for FOH's Medical Employability Program for nearly a year. Prior to joining the FOH team, the Michigan native was a fellow in occupational and environmental medicine at the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health, where she also earned her Master's in Public Health (MPH). She was the Freddie Mac Wellness Center's Medical Director in McLean, VA for four years before earning her MPH. Dr. Shiner obtained her medical degree from the University of Virginia School of Medicine and has been practicing internal medicine for 15 years.
